



## “Have I Got News For You” The Board Game Rules

### Setting Up

Divide all the players into 2 teams (A & B), choose a coloured pawn and a scoreboard (set at 00).

Place both play pawns on the Start space.

Sort out the cards into the 5 categories and arrange the cards on the board in their relevant places.

‘Have I Got A Year For You’ and ‘Nerd Facts’ cards should be face down (so that players cannot read the questions and answers).

‘Odd One Out’, ‘Missing Words’ and ‘Tabloid Headlines’ should have their answers face down so that players can view these throughout the game.

Agree a time limit for the game (40 minutes is recommended).

### Play

Team A rolls the die, moves their pawn accordingly and follows the instructions on the square. Play then passes to Team B. Throughout the game, play alternates between both teams irrespective of whether either team answers a question correctly.

### The Questions

Details of the points are written on the board itself, beneath each of the card place settings. Cards should be returned to the bottom of each appropriate pile after every turn.
