

If Luke wins flip the card to show the Millennium Falcon and replace the target with a new face down card.

The Winner replaces the targeting cards they used so they hold four cards again.

Play like a tug of war, the Ship card moves closer to the loser on each turn and is flipped to show who won the last card, Empire or Rebels.

#### **THE WINNER:**

Repeat the previous steps until one player moves the Ship card off the line.

Will the Death Star get in firing range or will the Rebels defeat Vader and send him fleeing...

#### **OTHER WAYS TO PLAY**

To balance the game for different ages give the youngest player one extra card.

For a longer battle lay seven cards face down between the players.

## **Death Star Attack**

### **Game Rules**

#### **AIM OF THE GAME:**

Be the first player to move the Ship card off the row. Will the Death Star get in firing range or will the Rebels defeat Vader and send him fleeing...

#### **GET READY:**

Take a seat opposite of the other player. Remove the Ship card. Shuffle the other cards and lay five number side down in a line from one player to another. Place the Ship card Death Star side up next to the 3rd card. Deal four cards face down to each player. Put the rest in a draw pile.

#### **HOW TO PLAY:**

Look at your cards. Now turn over the card next to the Death Star. The number on the card is your Target. You must race to match the number using your four Targeting cards. You can add or subtract the numbers in your hand in any order to try to match the Target. You can use any number of cards to achieve a match. If you can't match call out a number that is as close as you can get. The first player who makes a match or gets the closest moves the Ship card one space towards the other player.
